

Nighthawk Partners Inc. Business Continuity Planning Notification

Nighthawk Partners Inc. (sometimes “we” or the “Firm”) has developed a Business Continuity Plan on how we will respond to events that significantly disrupt our business. Since the timing and impact of disasters and disruptions is unpredictable, we will have to be flexible in responding to actual events as they occur. With that in mind, we are providing you with this information on our business continuity plan.

Contacting Us – If after a significant business disruption you cannot contact us as you usually do at (201) 944-2211 or by ralph@nighthawkpartners.com, you can reach us at mobile phone (201) 315 – 9492 (Ralph Grimaldi) and (646) 295-3746 (Ben Yaffee). If you cannot access us through either of those means, you should contact directly the private investment funds in which you are an investor for information regarding your investment.

Our Business Continuity Plan – We plan to quickly recover and resume business operations after a significant business disruption and respond by safeguarding our employees and our own property, making a financial and operational assessment, protecting the firm’s books and records, and assisting investors in contacting the funds in which they are invested. In short, our business continuity plan is designed to permit our firm to resume operations as quickly as possible, given the scope and severity of the significant business disruption.

Our business continuity plan addresses: data back up and recovery; all mission critical systems; financial and operational assessments; alternative communications with investors, employees, and regulators; alternate physical location of employees; critical supplier, contractor, bank and counter-party impact; regulatory reporting; and assisting our investors to contact the funds in which they are invested.

Varying Disruptions – Significant business disruptions can vary in their scope, such as only our firm, a single building housing our firm, the business district where our firm is located, the city where we are located, or the whole region. Within each of these areas, the severity of the disruption can also vary from minimal to severe. In a disruption to only our firm or a building housing our firm, we will transfer our operations to a local site when needed and expect to recover and resume business generally within 24 hours. In a disruption affecting our business district, city, or region, we will transfer our operations to a site outside of the affected area, and recover and resume business generally within 24 hours. However, depending on the extent of the affected area, we may be unable to do so. In either situation, to the extent possible, we plan to continue in business and notify you by telephone or email how to contact us. In the highly unlikely event the significant business disruption is so severe that it prevents us from remaining in business, to the extent possible, we will assist you in making sure that you have the appropriate contact information for the funds in which you have investments.
